### Subject: Award of Contract, Cloud Based Hosting Services for Asset Management Software, Bid 516-001

WHEREAS, The vice president of instructional and information technology/chief information officer and the senior vice president for administrative and fiscal services is requesting the purchase of cloud based hosting services for its licensed asset management software utilized by the Office of Information Technology's service desk for managing trouble tickets, asset inventory, and associated contracts; and

WHEREAS, This software tracks more than 55,000 service desk calls annually, as well as 25,000 units of inventory needed to support the day-to-day operations of the College; and

WHEREAS, Consistent with collegewide budget reduction measures, the Office of Information Technology has determined that greater efficiencies and cost savings can be achieved by rebidding certain information technology contracts; and

WHEREAS, The director of procurement certifies that specifications were developed by appropriate College staff, and the vice president of finance/chief financial officer certifies funds are available in the FY16 operating budget; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Md. (Educ.) Ann. Sec. 16-311, a request for proposal was publicly advertised on July 2, 2015, in a local county newspaper and posted on the Montgomery College Procurement and eMaryland Marketplace websites, and downloaded by 75 firms; and

WHEREAS, Two responses were received, publicly opened, read aloud and recorded, beginning at 3:00 pm on July 24, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Upon evaluation by appropriate College staff, it was determined that the proposal submitted by Stefanini, Inc., of Southfield, Michigan, was the highest ranked, meeting all College requirements; and

WHEREAS, Board approval is required for bids valued above \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, The president of the College recommends the following action; now therefore be it

<u>Resolved</u>, That a contract be awarded to Stefanini, Inc., of Southfield, Michigan, for the purchase of cloud based hosting services for licensed asset management software for a total amount of \$748,695 for the first year of the contract; and be it further

WHEREAS, The vice president of facilities and security and the senior vice president for administrative and fiscal services is requesting an award of contract for the construction of a centralized waste and trash collection project for the Germantown Campus; and

WHEREAS, The Germantown Campus will consolidate the collection of waste and recycling materials and use trash compactors to efficiently manage the waste stream; and

WHEREAS, The director of procurement certifies that specifications were developed by appropriate College staff, and the vice president of finance/chief financial officer certifies funds are available in the FY16 capital budget; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Md. (Educ.) Ann. Sec. 16-311, a request for proposal was publicly advertised on September 4, 2015, in the *Baltimore Sun* and the *Washington Post,* and posted on the Montgomery College Procurement website and eMaryland Marketplace and downloaded by 36 firms; and

WHEREAS, Five responses were received and recorded in the office of procurement on October 1, 2015, at 3:00 p.m. local time; and

WHEREAS, After evaluation of technical proposals, four of the five vendors that submitted proposals were deemed qualified, and had their price proposals opened and evaluated; and

WHEREAS, Following evaluation of price proposals, it was determined that CDCI, Inc., of Rockville, Maryland, submitted the lowest base bid price of \$291,790 and met all College specifications; and

WHEREAS, Board approval is required for bids valued above \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, The president of the College recommends the following action; now therefore be it

<u>Resolved</u>, That a contract for providing all necessary materials, labor, equipment, and insurance for construction of a centralized waste and trash collection structure for the Germantown Campus be awarded to CDCI, Inc., of Rockville, Maryland, for a total of \$291,790.

### ADOPTION OF FY17 CAPITAL BUDGET

### BACKGROUND

The proposed FY17 capital budget and six-year FY17–22 capital improvement program were presented and discussed at the October 19, 2015, Board of Trustees meeting. The capital improvements program is supported by and implements the College's Facilities Master Plan. The request for FY17 is the first half of the FY17–18 biennial capital budget and totals \$67,611,000. A copy of the proposed capital budget was distributed to the Board at its October meeting. The Board's adoption of the proposed FY17 capital budget is necessary for the county executive's consideration of these requests in the county's capital improvements program. Attached is a summary table that shows the proposed FY17 request by project, along with the actual FY16 appropriation for each project.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees adopt the FY17 capital budget, which requests a total of \$67,611,000 in FY17 and authorize the transmittal of the budget to the county government.
