NURS 205: Transition to Professional Nursing Practice (1 Credit)

COURSE DESCRIPTION

NURS 205 facilitates the entry of the graduate into the profession of nursing, including trends in the scope of practice and roles of the nurse in an ever-changing health care delivery system. Includes delineation of the major functions of professional nursing organizations, principles of management and coordination of nursing activities, accountability in nursing practice, identification of socio-political factors influencing professional nursing and an introduction to nursing research. Legal and ethical responsibilities related to nursing practice are further considered. **Co- Requisite:** NURS 240

Course Outcomes

- 2. Apply concepts of professional and non-professional behavior within clinical nursing practice.
