The number of courses needed to complete the requirement are dependent on a student's foreign language placement score at Loyola. The foreign language requirement may be fulfilled by: 1) completion of a modern or classical language at the 104 level or higher at Loyola, 2) a score of "5" on the Spanish, Italian, French, German, or Chinese AP exam, or a score of "4" or higher on the Latin AP exam, or 3) completion of a foreign language through the Intermediate II level at a regionally accredited college or university.
