Come join us for a special panel discussion led by Mr. Frank Islam on Social Justice, Democracy, and Globalization: Higher Education Today. Joining Mr. Islam will be our distinguished guests Dr. William Kirwan, Dr. C. Raj Kumar, and Dr. Tia Brown McNair.

Dr. William Kirwan is a nationally recognized authority on critical issues facing higher education. He served as chancellor of the University System of Maryland (2002-2015), president of the Ohio State University (1998-2002), and president of the University of Maryland, College Park (1988-1998). Prior to his presidency, he was a member of the University of Maryland mathematics faculty for 24 years.

Dr. C. Raj Kumar in an accomplished legal scholar and works in the fields of human rights and development, comparative constitutional law, terrorism and national security, corruption and governance, law and disaster management, and legal education and higher education.

Dr. Tia Brown McNair oversees both funded projects and AAC&U's continuing programs on equity, inclusive excellence, high-impact practices, and student success. McNair directs AAC&U's Summer Institutes on High-Impact Practices and Student Success, and TRHT Campus Centers and serves as the project director for several AAC&U initiatives, including the development of a TRHT-focused campus climate toolkit.
