Montgomery College Full-time Faculty of the Year Award

Purpose of the Montgomery College Full-time Faculty of the Year Award

The Montgomery College Full-time Faculty of the Year Award is intended to recognize an individual faculty member who has sustained excellence in all classifications: in teaching or counseling/academic advising, in scholarly or professional accomplishments, and in service to the institution and/or the community.

The award identifies one faculty member who is most representative of all qualities attributed to outstanding faculty and who represents the crème de la crème of all the nominees. The faculty member will have demonstrated phenomenal teaching or counseling/advising, an inspiring and long lasting effect on student learning and student success, unique and substantial scholarly or professional accomplishments, and significant and sustained service to the College and the community.

Selection Process

The MCOFA Committee, using a rubric, will select the Montgomery College Full-time Faculty of the Year Award from the pool of applicants for that year. It is recommended that the Full-time Faculty of the Year Award be selected first.

Criteria for Montgomery College Full-time Faculty of the Year Award

Criteria for nominating a candidate may include but are not limited to the criteria listed for the excellence in teaching, in counseling/advising, in scholarly or professional accomplishments, and in service to the institution and/or the community.

MC Full-Time Faculty of the Year will be invited to be a member of the MCOFA Committee the year following his or her award.
